POLICY: The Open Container Permit policy provides instructions for employees to support consistency in the issuance of the Open Container Permits to protect public safety and welfare during these types of events

CODE: 5.08.420 Open Container Restrictions

It is unlawful:

Section 4. To possess or dispense alcoholic liquor or malt beverages in an open container in any open space and certain structures in the city unless a license or permit authorizing same has been issued by the City Manager or his or her designee.

PROCEDURES: An application meeting all the stipulations and requirements below may be issued an open container permit.

Are you going to check identifications & issue wristbands to verify persons are 21 years of age and older?

- A. Identification check and wristbands to verify all persons consuming alcohol are 21 years of age and older are required within the open container boundary, without a wristband persons will be in violation of the open container ordinance and will be cited.

If your event has any live or amplified music have you contacted the Casper Police Department?

Chapter 8.20 – Noise - It is unlawful for any person to make, continue to cause to be made or continued, any loud, unnecessary or unusual noise or noises by yelling, singing, whistling, shouting or otherwise, which annoys, disturbs, injures or endangers the comfort, repose, health, peace or safety of any person within the city. It is unlawful for any person to use, operate or permit to be played, used or operated, any radio receiving set, musical instrument, phonograph or other machine or device for the production or reproduction of sound in any manner that disturbs the peace, quiet and comfort of any person in the city at any time with a louder volume than is necessary for convenient hearing for the person or persons who are in the room, vehicle or chamber in which such machine or device is operated and who are voluntary listeners thereto. The operation of such set, instrument, phonograph, machine or device so as to generate a sound pressure level in excess of 15 dB (A) over the levels allowable in Table [8.20.040](#) measured at a distance of not less than fifty feet from such building, structure or vehicle and of any time duration, shall be prima facie evidence of a violation of this section.

- B. The boundaries of the event must be clearly marked with signage stating that any alcoholic beverages taken outside of the licensed area will be open container violations of the Casper Municipal Code.

- C. Open container permits for large festivals or for the City Park Areas will require a description of the area where the open containers will be allowed.

- H. Failure to abide by this policy will result in the revocation of the open container permit and malt beverage or catering permit. The open container permit can be revoked at any time on the discretion of the Chief of Police or his or her designee if the event poses a risk to the public safety or welfare. Upon revocation, all sales of liquor must end and no open containers will be allowed. Any past revocations or violation will be considered in the issuance of any permits in the future.
