

**REQUEST FOR BIDS
WEED MOWING AND LITTER ABATEMENT
FOR THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT
CITY OF CASPER, CASPER, WYOMING**

Notice is hereby given, pursuant to Wyoming Statute, Section 15-1-113, that the City of Casper, Wyoming, will receive sealed bids until **4:00 P.M.**, Local Time, **Friday, March 16, 2018**, for the following services:

1. Weed / grass cutting and removal.
2. Litter and trash removal.

Bids must be in one sealed envelope with statement thereon **“BID ENCLOSED, WEED MOWING AND LITTER ABATEMENT.”** Return address/company information shall also be written on the envelope, and submitted to the Community Development Department, City Hall, 200 North David, Room 205, Casper, Wyoming, at or before, the above stated time. Bids will be opened publicly, read aloud, and tabulated by the Community Development Director, or his or her Designee, at 4:30 P.M., Local time, March 16, 2018 in the Community Development Office. No bid may be withdrawn for a period of thirty (30) days after the date set for opening thereof. The City of Casper, Wyoming, reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive any informalities or technicalities in the bidding. All bidders must have reached the age of majority and have the authority to enter into legal and binding contracts with the City of Casper, Wyoming, and show proof of the required insurance, workers’ compensation and hold harmless agreement. Proposals received after the above deadline will be returned to the bidder unopened.

Bidding documents, including specifications and scope of services, are currently available under the “Public Notice” section of the City’s website (www.Casperwy.gov). Bids will be evaluated on the thoroughness of the firm’s bids; ability to perform the service; the firm’s qualification and experience on similar type of projects; and references.

It is the intent of the City of Casper, Community Development Department to award contracts to a minimum of two (2), and a maximum of five (5) separate bidders, based on the criteria set forth in the bidding documents. The successful bidder(s) must be able to commence work on **May 1, 2018**, and continue on the program, up to and through, **April 30, 2019**.

Bidders who are residents of the State of Wyoming will receive preference as provided by Wyoming Statute, Section 16-6-101 et seq.
