Mayor Sandoval called the meeting to order at 4:36 p.m. with the following Councilmembers present: Councilman Cathey, Johnson, Heili, Humphrey, Miller, Hopkins, Powell, and Sandoval. Councilman Pacheco was absent.

Council reviewed the applications for the Retail Liquor License No. 37. Each applicant was allowed thirty minutes to give their presentation and answer Council's questions. Mayor Sandoval explained the scoring process for the presentations. Each Councilman received a tally sheet that had rankings from 1 to 6. After all of the presentations were completed, each Councilmember was to rank each presenter, with each ranking being assigned to one presenter. Then, the rankings are to be tallied by Vice Mayor Cathey. Mayor Sandoval stated that Council's decision about who will be allowed to officially apply for the license will be made tonight and will be announced at the end of the meeting. He also noted that public comment is isolated to those that are presenting.

Council then filled out their tally sheets. Before the final decision was announced, Council commented on the presentations as a whole and the liquor license awarding process.

Mayor Sandoval announced that Yellowstone Garage's proposal received the highest score from Council, and would thus be the business that is allowed to apply for Retail Liquor License No. 37. City Manager McDonald explained what the next steps will be for that application.

Next, City Manager McDonald reviewed the current state of the City's budget. The City's sales tax revenue came in as planned for this month. The City does not have the results from last year's revenue yet. He stated that each department's monthly budget will be closely monitored.

City Manager McDonald then reviewed the agenda for the Regular Council Meeting on August 2, 2016.

Next, Council went around the table to discuss their respective board meetings. The Poplar and Old Yellowstone District boundaries will be added to a work session for Council to discuss.

Mayor Sandoval adjourned the meeting at 8:30 p.m.
