Recommendation

That Council provide staff direction with regard to allowing the Platte River Trails Trust (PRTT) to demolish an antiquated bridge on the Rail Trail east of Casper towards Edness Kimball Wilkins State Park (EKW).

Summary

PRTT has approached the City of Casper with an offer to demolish the old concrete bridge that aligns with the Rail Trail past Hat Six Road. This property and structure are owned by the City and was obtained in the late 1990's. The bridge provides no utility and is an attractive nuisance. City staff would like to see it removed to avoid future liability.

PRTT has found a generous donor who would like to further the overall goal of seeing the trail system extend to EKW. The removal of this bridge and building of a soft surface trail in its place would further this goal.

Two additional goals to see this project to its completion would be to obtain a recreational trail grant from the State and to obtain an easement through a small (800 foot) section of State land. Both of these endeavors would need to be sponsored by the City with Councils approval.
