That Council provide direction on the titles to be used for members of Council.

Summary

Recently the issue of what members of Council's officials' titles should be has been discussed. Often it is up each individual member or the Mayor to decide how to address each other. Council Leadership felt that a more formal process to adopt a title for all would provide clarity and direction for all use and future use.

Currently, some members of Council are referred to as Councilman, Councilwoman, or Councilmember. In formal written documents such as Council Handbook, Code of Ethics, City of Casper Website, agendas and scripts the term used is Councilmember for all of Council.

According to the National League of Cities, "The title for the members of city councils vary, and several titles exist according to local custom. These titles are: councilmember, alderman, selectman, freeholder, trustee or commissioner." Based on research of municipalities in the United States, the most common titles used are Alderman/Alderwoman, Councilmember, or Councilman/Councilwoman. Another title that has been suggested is Councilor or Councillor.

At this time, Council can discuss and decide which titles should be used in writing and speaking and then can adopt this vernacular by resolution at a formal Council Meeting.
