Summary:

The leading objective of this effort is to update the 2014 Long Range Transportation Plan (LRTP) for the Casper, Mills, Evansville, Bar Nunn, and Natrona County areas, and to provide a plan for the development of transportation facilities for the next thirty (30) years. The LRTP is being developed in coordination with the Casper Area Metropolitan Planning Organizations and participating City and Town councils. The final deliverable will serve not only as a policy guide for local municipalities, but will also guide state and federal funding of key transportation facilities and infrastructure.

The project team has recently launched a project website: www.connectingcrossroads.com and are encouraging the public to take a survey to give initial feedback regarding transportation related values and priorities. At this time, the project team is preparing for a series of workshops from March 12 – 14, at Casper College, to explore transportation topics in detail related to:

- Community Growth Scenarios
- Redevelopment Areas
- Bicycle, Pedestrian, and Trail Network Analysis
- Public Transit
- Safety Hotspots
- Congestion Hotspots

The final LRTP will be presented to the Casper City Council for review and adoption in October 2019.
