

COUNCIL WORK SESSION – May 27, 2014

Mayor Meyer called the meeting to order at 4:30 p.m. with the following Councilmembers present: Councilmen Goodenough, Hopkins, Cathey, Powell, Schlager, Hedquist and Bertoglio. Absent: Councilman Sandoval.

The first item on the agenda was a presentation by Kerry Davis, consultant from Preservation Solutions LLC regarding a recent grant project to survey and complete an inventory of historical buildings in the Casper Downtown area and the Old Yellowstone District. The report dealt with 210 properties and included recommendations for future survey data and for nominating properties to the National Register of Historic Places.

Councilman Sandoval joined the meeting at 4:55 p.m.

The second item on the agenda was a recommendation from the Leisure Services Board for the FY2015 fees at Hogadon. Doug Follick presented the report which included a 5% increase in fees for Adult Daily Lift Tickets and Season Tickets.

At 5:20 p.m. it was moved by Councilman Schlager and seconded by Councilman Sandoval to adjourn into Executive Session to discuss Contract Negotiations. The vote in favor was unanimous.
