SUBJECT:

Council's Vote for use of the Optional 1% #15 Sales Tax Special Projects

Funds and Committing Sales Tax Funds to Said Priorities.

Recommendation:

That Council provide direction to Staff on how to allocate One Cent Funds.

Summary:

On September 4, 2018, Council met in a Work Session to allocate \$6 million One Cent funds to various applicants.

Council discussed the best way to divide the money. Council asked Staff to come up with a recommendation for how to allocate the money to community projects, and also to take into consideration other City projects of high priority that could use more funding, even if that was above the six million dollars set aside for community projects.

On September 11, 2018, Council met in a Work, and staff presented their recommendation. Staff pointed out that when the initial commitment to the agencies was made roughly four (4) years ago in 1% #15, it was under the assumption that sixty-eight million dollars (\$68,000,000) would be generated through the one cent program. When the \$68M was adjusted downward in light of the weaker receipts being collected, the agency commitments were not adjusted downward. Therefore, it seems that the \$8M to other agencies in the current cycle is disproportionately large. However, Staff recognize the benefit of supporting agencies that aid the poor directly and contracting with agencies that do work that would otherwise be expected of the City.

Further, Staff, based on Council's suggestion, recommended not funding new and/or late requests. Staff also recommended not funding other government agencies.

Additionally, CATC (\$1.6M), the Trails Trust (\$1M), Casper Housing Authority, and The Nic were moved from the community project line of funding, as the City is contracting with them to maintain City services or infrastructure.

In light of staff recommendation, Council suggested another voting sheet be sent out, with the Staff recommendations included, as well as a description sheet for the other City items which would be second priority projects. Six (6) Councilmembers returned their voting sheets. Staff compiled the data and averaged the Council's votes. It is now presented for Council's consideration.
