I. <u>ELECTION OF OFFICERS</u>

<u>Fred Feth</u> called the meeting to order. <u>Mr. Trembath</u> explained the election process, and advised the Planning & Zoning Commission to elect a substitute presiding officer for the election process.

PLN-20-029-RZ — A plat creating the <u>Trails West Estate No. 4 Addition</u>, consisting of a vacation and replat of Lots 1-4, Block 16, Cottonwood Addition, Lots 13-19, Block 17, Trails West Estates, and Lot 20A, Block 17, Trails West Estates No. 3, and Lot 14 of Lots 8-14, Block 17, Trails West Estates No. 2, and the Westerly Portion of Indian Scout Drive, and the southerly portion of Whispering Springs Road; AND a petition for a zone change from Zoning Classifications PUD (Planned Unit Development) and R-1 (Residential Estates) to entirely R-1 (Residential Estates).
